We started our first rounds with Sportsman and F3A which did become very interesting for Scott in F3A class as a number of the top line manoeuvres went missing in the clouds, a few seconds it appeared in the correct position. We had 10 pilots which was excellent considering the weather leading up to the comp plus some were on holidays. By lunchtime at 12.30 we had completed two rounds of all classes, so then after lunch we needed to complete one more round of all classes to make it a comp before the weather changes. At the end of the third round all agreed that we could do another round which worked very well as the weather had improved a little. It was good to have David Cook back with some excellent flying and also Stephen Barrow both have missed a few comps due to other commitments, well done guys welcome back.

This round has shown the closest score we have had for sometime in Advance between Terry and Kevin both from the LMAC club, with Terry taking the win with 2991.77 and Kevin's score 2991.60. A number of pilots gained promotional points towards moving up to the next class, well done to all including Scott Kay gaining his promotion to Masters.
